
 Two cardboard tubes (you can use toilet roll tubes)



String








• Hale puncher or pen






(I) Cut your paper to size, then cover your tubes with glue and wrap the paper around them.




 Using a pen or hole puncher, insert a hole at the side of each tube, about a third of the way down.




3 Glue the two tubes together so that the holes are facing the outside.




4 Insert string into one of the holes from the outside of the tube. Bring it through the tube and tie a chunky knot. Gently pull the string back from the outside. Repeat on the other side.



The knot will stop the string coming back through the hole. (5) Place a rubber band around the tubes to help the glue set. Leave to dry over night.



(6) Remove the elastic band and then decorate them with pens!
