The Score system is designed to achieve the best possible outcome against the HAP requirements.

The benchmark of 80mm of substrate, with a Score of 0 is the starting point.

Scores over 20 are rated Excellent

Scores over 20 are rated Excellent Scores over 15 are rated Good

Scores over 15 are rated Good

A roof can be designed to benefit more than one habitat or group of species.

However, the benefit will be reduced if many habitats are attempted on one roof.
