

## Case study: The Apple Shack

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### **Name of project or group**

The Apple Shack, Manchester Road/Blackbrook Bridge, Sheffield. Case study by Hermione, August 2022

### **What actions for nature did your business want to take and why?**

The Apple Shack is Sheffield's eco-friendly, outdoor spot for delicious cakes, teas and coffees.

We have started planting trees around the borders of the fields surrounding The Apple Shack, to create wildlife corridors and increase the biodiversity of the area.

We grow our own apples which we use to juice and put in our homemade cakes, hence our name, The Apple Shack! We use recycled paper to serve our cakes which we then compost and use on our flower beds, which the bees love. We have 6 hives just up the field. We offer a ten percent discount to people who bring their own mugs, but we don't offer takeaway materials anyway, only reusable mugs that we wash. So every weekend we only produce a very small amount of waste that is all composted!
