
## Temporary Traffic Regulation Order, Greno Woods

This autumn felling operations relating to an outbreak of larch dieback and associated Statutory Plant Health Notice are to be carried out in Greno Woods. To facilitate public safety during the works and the safe removal of timber via Sandy Lane, the Trust has applied to temporarily close the Sandy Lane byway and a number of footpaths and sections of bridleway that cross the Sandy Lane woodstacking area. The proposed closures are shown on the map below



Other than the restrictions/closures shown all other footpaths, bridleways and permissive routes will remain open as normal.

It is the Trust's intention that public access to the woods is restricted as little as possible so the affected rights of way will only be closed when necessary for public safety, and individual rights of way may be opened for periods during the works when it is safe to do so. Fortunately, the large

Rights of Way network at Greno mean that safe access to the reserve will be possible for walkers, cyclists and horse riders throughout the duration of the works.

Access to the properties adjacent to Sandy Lane will be maintained at all times, and the Trust is already in communication with these property owners.
