



Writing your Will

Writing your Will is incredibly personal - it is a document that reflects the people, causes and places that are important to you.

Keeping your Will up-to-date will give you peace of mind that your wishes will be carried out as you intend.

After you have taken care of your loved ones, any gift you give, no matter how big or small, can be used by Sheffield & Rotherham Wildlife Trust to make sure that nature is protected and wildlife thrives.

Types of Gifts

There are three main types of gifts that you can leave in your Will. Any amount that you leave, even a 1% share of your estate, will help us to support species and the habitats they depend on.

A residuary gift is the remainder, or a percentage of the remainder of your estate, once all other gifts and expenses have been made.

A pecuniary gift is a specified sum of money.

A specific gift is a specific, named item such as jewellery, work of art or property.
